Lions ski club is run entirely by volunteers. Members meet to ski on Sunday mornings at Snozone Castleford.

We have been instructing and coaching skiers for over forty years and are proud to have helped so many people learn to ski and develop their skiing skills.

Lion's racers have gone on to represent the club, their regions and Great Britain in racing to great success. Perhaps more importantly members enjoy skiing together, developing their skills and having fun.

Our qualified instructors and coaches will help you and your family develop your skiing skills regardless of whether you're just moving on from the basics right through to high level race training.

The race team have an additional session on Monday evenings which is open to members by invitation only.

## Who can attend Lions Ski Club Sunday sessions?

Everyone who attends Lions needs to meet Snozone's recreational slope standard: control speed, link turns and use the Poma lift. We cannot teach beginners.

Everyone is welcome. There's no age limit (young or old!).

## Membership

The Lions membership year runs from 1<sup>st</sup> July to 30<sup>th</sup> June each year and currently costs just £1 per person annually. For new members there is an initial joining fee of £5 per person to cover administration costs.

Guests may attend Lions twice annually. To attend more than this, skiers need join the club.

Please note that Lions membership is distinct and separate from Snozone membership; please see the end of this document for information relating to Snozone membership.\*

## Session times and prices:

### Sunday mornings: 8.00 – 10.00 a.m.

Lion's members who are also Snozone members can purchase a session pass for just £15.49 from Snozone plus £5 club sub's. The price is the same for adults and juniors. Snozone slope fees need to be paid at the Snozone front desk and Lion's sub's at the Lion's desk, which is immediately opposite. See below for information on Snozone membership costs and ID requirements.

Non-Snozone members pay standard Snozone slope fees (As at 24/11/16: Adult, £36.99/ Child, £31.99) plus £5 club subs. The Snozone slope fee also covers ski, boot and helmet hire (subject to availability).

We suggest arriving in plenty of time (up to 30 minutes early, particularly if you have young children) to allow for any queues when paying SNOZONE slope fees/Lion's sub's or for equipment hire and to allow time to get out on the slope at 8.00. Juniors are required to wear helmets and all attendees wear suitable clothing and gloves as they will be in a temperature of -5°C for 2 hours. Salopettes and jackets are usually available to hire from SNOZONE at extra cost.

Parents are not allowed to instruct their own children and all children must be part of our structured training groups, based on ability. Prompt attendance allows us to allocate groups effectively. All children (under 16) must wear a numbered bib to allow us to identify them. Bibs are issued next to the Lions payment desk.

### **Monday night race training. By invitation only: 7.30 – 9.30 pm**

Snozone slope fees as above plus £5 sub's for those race training. No guests allowed.
